C I R C U L A R

ICAR has approved the OPD and IPD treatments for ICAR-NINFET regular staffs & their dependent, IPD treatment for pensioners & their dependents as per official records at the following hospitals from the date of issue of this circular till the currency of the said Hospital being on the CGHS list of approved hospitals, in terms of the Department of Health, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India OM NO.FNS-14025/72000-MS dated 28.03.2000 / W.B. Health for all Employees and Pensioners Cashless Medical Treatment Scheme,2014. All IPD treatment will be on cashless basis as per CGHS rates and norms. Charges for non-CGHS items will be borne by the beneficiary at the time of availing treatment and same will be reimbursed from ICAR-NINFET on production of original bill as per rule.

The following terms and condition should be followed by staff /pensioner of ICAR-NINFET, Kolkata.

1. Regular employees and their dependents are eligible for indoor and outdoor facilities at the empanelled Hospital. Pensioners and their dependents are eligible for indoor facilities only.
2. At the time of admission to the hospital valid Medical Identity Card (along with photo copy) issued from ICAR-NINFET and at least one valid photo ID proof should be produced to the hospital authority. The photocopy of both the cards will be retained by the hospital.
3. ICAR-NINFET will pay the claims of the hospital as per CGHS approved rates only on production of original bill to the hospital directly. The non-CGHS items will be settled by the patient party during the time of discharge/release from the hospital. The bills for non-CGHS items may be claimed by the beneficiary from ICAR-NINFET separately which will be reimbursed as per rule.
4. Ambulance services shall be provided by the Hospitals as per rule within the city subject to availability of the same under very special circumstances. However, the patient party will bear the expenses.
5. In case of the eligible bed/room as per entitlement of the staff is not available/higher bed category is needed for specialized treatment/patient party opts for a higher category of bed/room, the excess payment will be recovered from the patient party by the hospital during the time of discharge.
6. Duration of hospitalization of the patients for a particular package/procedure will be within a reasonable/justifiable length (07 days). However, in case of any complications developed, such extended stay for a longer duration will be intimated to the ICAR-NINFET authority by the Hospital.
7. OPD bills for regular staff and their dependents in respect of doctor's consultation fees and pathological & radiological tests only will be paid directly to the hospital as per empanelment mentioned on pre-page (refer column 3 of Table-A). The cost of medicine as per rule will be reimbursed to staff from ICAR-NINFET on production of bill/prescription separately.
8. This empanelment will not be applicable for medical insurance cases.

9. Medical Card will be issued by Adm-I Section to all regular staffs/retired employees and their dependents. But the card should be returned to Adm-I Section, in case of his/her son starts earning, or attains the age of 25 years and daughter starts earning, or gets married, whichever is earlier. In case of death of any family members, the same should be intimated to the office and medical card should be returned immediately.
10. In Peerless Hospital the dental, eye and neuro department are excluded from this tie up. However, the patient may undergo treatment for these mentioned categories and it may be reimbursed to the staff/pensioners as per rules on production of original bill.
11. In case of any unruly behaviour/external political influence/damage of the hospital property by any beneficiary, the tie up with the particular hospital may be withdrawn from their side. In that case, responsibility will be fixed against the concerned beneficiary and appropriate disciplinary action will be initiated against him/her apart from legal action taken by the hospital.
12. This measure is for the welfare of the regular staff, pensioners and their dependents. Hence, all are requested to restrain from availing any unjustifiable treatments/benefits from the hospital.
